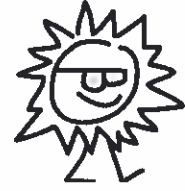

Formal dress for boys

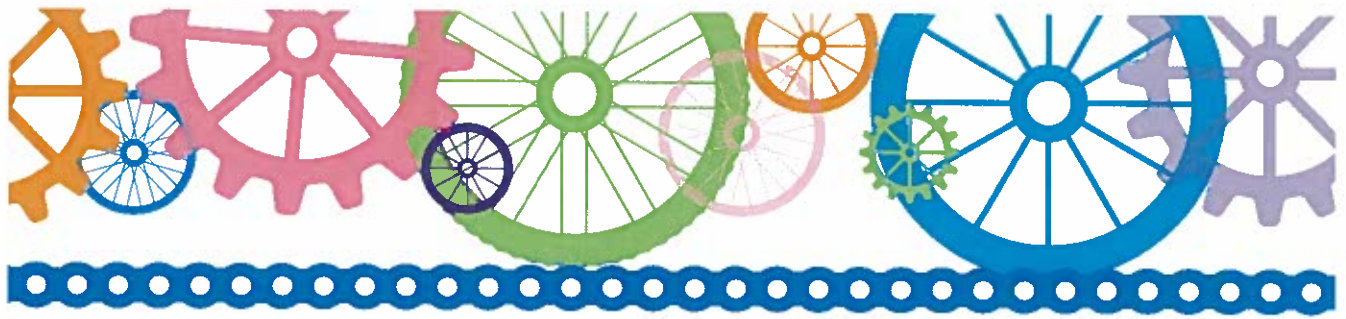
- No Jeans/Tees/Shorts
